



The Cramer United Methodist Retreat Center Information

Setting: The Cramer Retreat Center is available for use by churches and individuals desiring a rich, inspiring Christian experience in a pastoral setting. It is a perfect place for small group retreats, staff retreats, local church planning sessions, and small group retreats.

Accommodations: The Cramer Retreat Center currently has two guest houses set on 18 acres. There are three bedrooms in each house. Oxalis Cottage will sleep 13. Grapevine Arbor will sleep 12. Each house has two full baths and a kitchen. There is also a larger meeting room available in the Wellhouse Chapel. The Cramer Retreat Center is a no smoking facility.

Parking: **Parking is limited. Carpooling is highly recommended.** Each house has 5-6 parking slots. Please limit the number of vehicles brought onto the property. All vehicles must stay on gravel. Cars parked on the grass will be moved.

Labyrinth: We have a unique Cross Labyrinth in the woods behind Oxalis cottage. Information about the Cross Labyrinth can be found on the website.

What to Bring: You will need to plan to bring all personal items, including bedding and towels. You will need to bring everything you need to prepare your meals. A list of area merchants that cater or deliver can be made available at your request. There are microwaves, coffee makers, refrigerators, dishwashers, stoves/ovens, and washer/dryers in each house. Dish towels, hand towels, and cleaning supplies are provided. The Cramer Center does not currently have maintenance or cleaning crews. You will need to leave the Center as you found it. If you rearrange the furniture, please move it back.

- For day use only:
 - Monday – Thursday: \$5 per person (minimum 10)
 - Friday – Sunday \$10 per person (minimum 20)
- Overnight Stays: \$20 per person (minimum 5)
- Personal Retreat: Prices are quoted on an individual basis

Deposit and Payment Policies:

There is a non-refundable deposit required to confirm a reservation. Deposits are due within two weeks of submission of the reservation request form. After two weeks, if the deposit is not received, the date will be released.

Full payment is due two weeks prior to your event. Adjustments to the amount due can be made as necessary, but only with prior approval of the Property Manager.
